St. Mark's church, Main Road, Shavington, CW2 5DP.

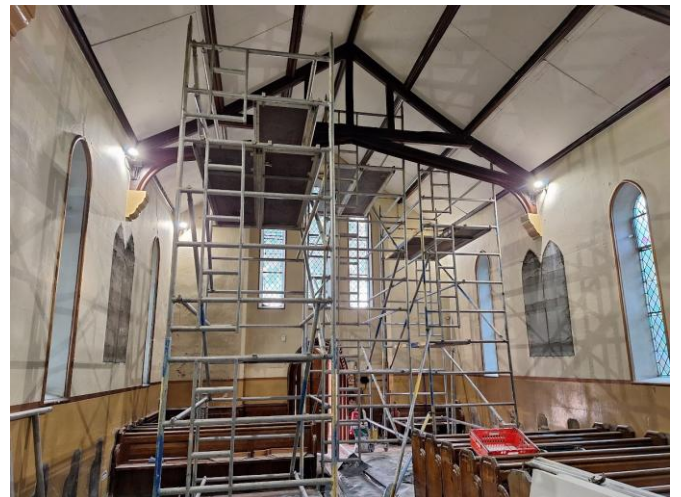
